Lal, RAS/TSK participated in an illegal strike on and from 8th May, 74 and instigated other railway workers to participate in the strike and also indulged in intimidation and threats of physical violence on other workers who wanted to continue to work thereby disrupting the normal working of the railway and the transportation of the goods essential for the life of the community which acts on his part involving participation in an illegal strike and intimidation of loyal workers amount to gross misconduct warranting removal from service.

2. WHEREAS in the interest of the Railway Administration, in the interest of the smooth running of the train services and the transportation of goods essential for the life of the community the retention of Shri S.N. Lal, RAS/TSK in service is considered as undesirable.

3. WHEREAS it is considered that the circumstances of the case are such and it is not reasonably practicable to hold an enquiry in the manner provided for in the Railway Servants' (Discipline and Appeal) Rules, 1968.

Memorandum Presented to the General Manager, T.S.P.

Sir,

This Memorandum presented to you by the National Co-ordination Committee for Railwaymen's Struggle, I.C.F. Unit, on behalf of the I.C.F. Workers and request ^{RCF} the same be forwarded to the appropriate authorities to take immediate action on the legitimate demands of the Railwaymen.

This mass rally of Railwaymen held under the auspicious of National Co-ordination Committee for Railwaymen's Struggle, I.C.F. Unit takes legitimate pride in the success of the efforts for consolidation of Railwaymen's Industrial, Categorical, Sectional, Recognised, Non-recognised, affiliates of Trade Union Centres and other independent organisations have come on one platform.

This Meeting deplores that even after this historic development, the Railway Ministry has not taken any step for a negotiated settlement of the demands.

This Meeting while lauding the decision of the National Convention of Railwaymen held at New Delhi on 27-2-1974, resolve to go on an "INDEFINITE STRIKE" for the realisation of the following demands from any date as decided upon by the National Co-ordination Committee:-

1. (a) All Railwaymen be treated as Industrial Workers with full Trade Union rights including the right to negotiate.
(b) The working hours of Railwaymen shall not exceed eight hours per day;
(c) There shall be a job evaluation of all Railwaymen through a scientific system to be followed by their reclassification and regradation with the need-based minimum wage as the wage for the lowest paid worker.
(d) Pending the completion of job evaluation and reclassification, immediate parity in wages with those workers in the Central Undertakings, viz., RMT, DRIL, IRIL, HAL etc.
Dearness allowance linked to the cost of living index with full neutralisation for every rise of

3. Bonus at the rate of one month's wage for the years 1971-72 and 1972-73.
4. Decasualisation of all casual railwaymen and their confirmation in service with all benefits given to them with retrospective effect.
5. Adequate and subsidised foodgrains and other essential commodities through departmental run shops.
6. All victimisation cases should be withdrawn.

This mass rally is fully conscious that this struggle will call for the greatest sacrifices from all sections of railwaymen and we pledge that we shall leave no stones unturned to lead the struggle to a successful end.
