ORDER

S.O. ¹⁵⁰⁶ IDRA/6/8 - In exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Industries (Development and Regulation) Act, 1951 (65 of 1951) read with Rules 4 and 5 of the Development Councils (Procedural) Rules, 1952, the Central Government hereby establishes a Development Council for the scheduled industries engaged in the manufacture or production of Inorganic Chemicals in place of the Development Councils for Alkalies & Allied Industries and for Acids & Fertilizers, established under this Ministry's Orders No. S.O. 953 dated the 24th April, 1959 and 955 dated the 27th April, 1959 respectively, and appoints the following persons to be members of the said Council for a period of two years with effect from the date of this Order:-





We presume that you are aware of the preparations currently going on for the Tagore Centenary Peace Festival to be held in Calcutta from November 3 - 12, 1961.

The General Council of the AITUC has adopted a resolution in this regard and both the WFTU and AITUC will be taking active part in this festival. The actual field-work is being conducted by our West Bengal Committee and we hope that our activists from all over the country will try their best to make this festival a success by rendering all assistance and taking part in it.

It has been decided to erect a pavilion in this festival along with other pavilions, to describe the theme - "TAGORE AND THE TOILERS" - in its various aspects.

We want that our worker-poets, writers and others with aptitudes for cultural and creative arts should take part in this festival and by their performances depict the true relationship Tagore had with the toiling people.

The All-India Committee of the Tagore Centenary Peace Festival has informed us that accommodation for the participants will be provided free and that food will be available at cheap rates. You should also try to approach the Railway Authorities at your end stating the number of expected number of participants for railway concession.

Ask our worker-artists, writers, poets and others to prepare themselves for performances at the festival. There is very little time left. Our participation and performance in the festival should be the best in order to truly portray Tagore's creation vis-a-vis the toiling people.
