
SUB :- PART TIME EMPLOYEES.

Dear Comrade,

We are informed by our representative on the Jute Wage Board, Com. Indrajit Gupta that he had been trying to get in touch with you for sometime now but without success. The Wage Board has decided to visit the Andhra centres from 28th July to 3rd August. It is necessary that our unions at Chittavalasa and Nellimarla should submit some memorandum to the Wage Board before 10th July in this connection.

Time for submission of replies to the Wage Board's Questionnaire has been extended to 10th July 1961 for non-Bengal centres.

Since the AITUC unions are dominant in jute in Andhra, it would be a matter of deep regret if you and the Chittavalasa and Nellimarla unions do not pay sufficient attention to presenting our case before the Wage Board.

We would therefore request you to move in the matter immediately and get in touch with Com. Indrajit Gupta at 15 Dover Road, Calcutta 19.
